
Key learning outcomes:

By the end of this course, students will:

- **Distinguish Between Natural and Cultured Pearls**: Learn the fundamental differences in origin, formation, and characteristics.
- Identify Pearl-Producing Molluscs: Recognize the species responsible for pearl creation.
- Evaluate Pearl Features: Understand and identify critical properties such as color, luster, size, and treatments.
- Analyze Value Factors: Discover what influences pearl pricing and market value.
- Learn Pearl Evaluation Tools and Systems: Gain insight into the evaluation techniques used in Bahrain and the region.
- Explore Pearl Care: Understand how to maintain pearls for longevity.

- Experience Pearl Diving and Traditional Tools: Participate in a hands-on pearl diving/snorkeling trip to explore traditional practices and the full use of molluscs, shells, and pearls.
- Understand Cultured Pearls: Learn about their origins, formation, and applications.
- **Differentiate Between Real and Imitation Pearls**: Recognize natural, cultured, fake, and imitation pearls.
- **Discover DANAT**: Understand its formation, role, and collaborations in the pearl industry.
- Learn About CIBJO: Explore its significance in the global jewelry industry.
- Address Environmental and Sustainability Factors: Understand how environmental influences and sustainable practices impact pearl growth, pearl oyster seabeds, and production.
- **Identify Advanced Testing Methods**: Learn about instruments and methods for detecting pearl treatments and artificial coloration.

This immersive course combines theoretical knowledge with practical experiences, offering a holistic understanding of pearls and their significance in culture, commerce, and sustainability.



Learning outcomes:

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Understand the difference between natural and cultured pearls
- Identify pearl producing molluscs
- Understand and identify the properties and features of pearls, eg: colour, lustre, size and treatment
- Identify and analyze the factors that influence the price and value of pearls.
- Understand and identify the tools and systems used in Bahrain and the region to evaluate pearls. To begin to understand how to care for pearls for longevity
- Understand, identify and use the tools once used in pearl diving and fishing in a practical way whilst on pearl diving/snorkeling trip. To understand that the whole shell, oyster and pearl can be used
- Understand the origins of cultured pearls, how they are formed and what they are used for.
- Understand that pearls can be natural, cultured, fake and imitation
- Understand how and why DANAT was formed, what is does and which entities it works with.
- Understand how and why CIBJO is important for the world jewellery industry
- Understand the environmental factors effecting the production of pearls. To recognize the importance of sustainability on pearl growth, pearl oyster seabeds and pearl production.
- Understand that instruments and testing methods are used to identify treatments and artificial coloration.
